## **Pipeline Infrastructure Improvements Update**

**Thursday, March 7, 2019**

**Dominion Energy Ohio Gas Pipeline Infrastructure Replacement Project - PIR 2168  
East 79th Street & St. Clair Avenue  
(City of Cleveland - Ward 10)**

**CLEVELAND** – On Thursday, March 7, 2019 Dominion Energy Ohio’s gas pipeline infrastructure replacement project will begin on the following street:

- East 79th Street – From St. Clair Avenue to 815 East 79<sup>th</sup> Street

The improvements include replacing the old steel mainline with a new plastic mainline in the sidewalk area. One lane of traffic will be maintained at all times within the project limits with traffic control personnel directing traffic flow.

A Law Enforcement Officer will be present at all signalized intersections. Access to adjacent driveways will be maintained throughout construction. All work zones will be removed at the end of each work day. The work will take place Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

This project is scheduled for completion in March 2019. If weather prevents permanent restorations to the sidewalk, a temporary sidewalk will be installed until permanent restorations can be completed in the spring.
