## **Pipeline Infrastructure Improvements Update**

**Monday, March 11, 2019**

**Dominion Energy Ohio Gas Pipeline Infrastructure Replacement Project - PIR 2870  
Lenacrave Avenue & East 116<sup>th</sup> Street  
(City of Cleveland - Ward 2)**

**CLEVELAND** – On Monday, March 11, 2019 Dominion Energy Ohio’s gas pipeline infrastructure replacement project will begin on the following streets:

- Lenacrave Avenue – From East 116<sup>th</sup> Street to Residence 12812 Lenacrave Avenue.
- East 116<sup>th</sup> Street – From Angelus Avenue to Dove Avenue.
- East 123<sup>rd</sup> Street – From Angelus Avenue to Dove Avenue.

The improvements include replacing the old steel mainline with a new plastic mainline in the sidewalk area. One lane of traffic will be maintained at all times on residential side-streets with traffic control personnel directing traffic flow. On East 116<sup>th</sup> Street, a work zone will be established in the curb lane only.

A Law Enforcement Officer will be present at all signalized intersections to assist with traffic flow. Access to adjacent driveways will be maintained throughout construction. All work zones will be removed at the end of each work day. The work will take place Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

This project is scheduled for completion, including restoration, in May 2019.
