**Players must play in (6) games to be eligible for playoffs.**

**Illegal participants AND the team manager will be suspended for four games and the team will forfeit all victories in which an illegal participant played.**

**Unsportsmanlike Conduct** will not be tolerated. Ask your manager to explain the conduct rules on pages 7 & 8 before the season begins. Also, alcoholic beverages are prohibited in Brookside and Gordon Parks; smoking is prohibited on the field or in the dugout.
