- Hosted Community Conversations and focus group discussions investigating the state of health disparities.

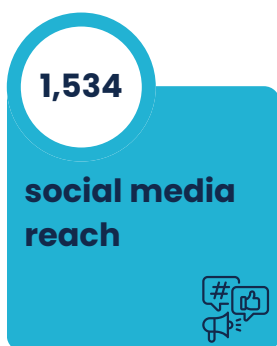
2023 By the Numbers
