COMH provides minority health data to local agencies working to improve the health status of minority populations.

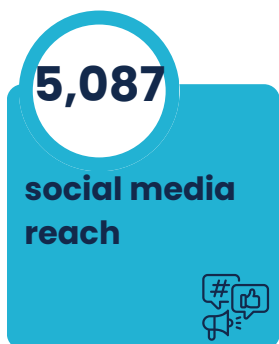
### Highlights
