

MomsFirst 2025 Annual Report

Division of Health Equity and Social Justice



MomsFirst supports new and expecting mothers, fathers, and babies. Participants are paired with a Community Health Worker (CHW) from pregnancy up until babies are 18 months old. MomsFirst provides home visits, health education, and referrals to other resources.

Highlights

- MomsFirst Community Baby Shower supported 140+ families. The event connected expectant families to resources, partner organizations, and community supports.
- In 2025, the Cleveland Infant Vitality Community Consortium (CIVCC) completed its first full year of implementation, aligning community members, public health, healthcare, and community partners around shared maternal health equity priorities.

- 411** participants served, including moms and dads
- 1,713** face-to-face participant visits that resulted in a service
- 133** babies born in MomsFirst
- 0.0** Infant Mortality Rate among MomsFirst participants (*Preliminary*)
