Chris Heltzel responded that requirement of CPRB to review departure letters at the next meeting assumes timely delivery of the departure letter to OPS and the CPRB which was not the case here. Chair Sharp stated that the appeal will be discussed and voted on in the next meeting because the letter was not delivered in a timely manner. All board members agreed. (4:46:35-4:50:59)

POLICY UPDATES: Sr. Investigator Funari stated that there were no policy updates. Chair Sharp stated that there were two policy recommendation that were discussed in today's meeting that will need to be followed up on at the next meeting. (4:51:09-4:51:32)

NEW BUSINESS: There was discussion amongst the board members if they were allowed to play video or audio during the board meeting when there is a question on the floor about something that was said. Member Brown asked if there is a policy or procedure in place that the board can go to. Chair Sharp stated that this was a question that was asked of legal counsel at the last board meeting if the board could do this. Member Hardy stated that maybe the board can go into executive session if this can't be done in the public setting. Chris Heltzel stated a lot of things come down to what is actually being played. If it is a dispatch call, they would need advance notice in order to allow someone in the Law Department to review whatever it is that needs to be played so that pertinent information can be redacted. Chair Sharp stated that that is the problem because the board is not able to listen to recordings during meetings and questions if the board can go into executive session to review these types of audio or video recordings. Council Heltzel stated that he would have to confirm what is exempt from public disclosure with legal under Ohio law. (4:51:44-5:00:52)
