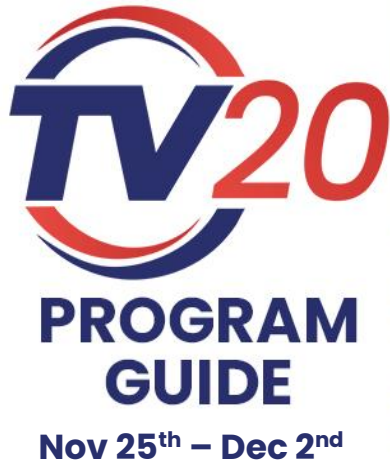

5. Community Housing Solutions: The city has a program that helps to make the homes of older Clevelanders more accessible? It's called the "age friendly home investment program. The program helps Cleveland residents 60 years and older, and adults with disabilities, make critical home repairs.
