Van Aken Blvd Project Press Release

**South Woodland to Shaker Blvd
(City of Cleveland - Ward 4)**

CLEVELAND – The City of Cleveland is planning a project that involves the repair and resurfacing of Van Aken Boulevard from South Woodland Avenue to Shaker Boulevard. In addition, the proposed project will also include pavement base repairs, casting adjustments, ADA compliant curb ramps and new pavement markings. Construction is currently scheduled to begin in May 2026 and completed by the end of the year.

The City is obliged, by Federal regulations, to have a thirty day public comment period as federal funds will be utilized for this project.

We welcome your questions and comments. Issues you may wish to comment on may include, but are not limited to, the effect of the project on local residents, project components, air quality, the local economy, and historic or cultural resources. Comments are requested by July 14, 2025, to ensure that they are considered during project development.
