Payne Avenue Rehabilitation Project – Phase 2
(East 30th Street to East 55th Street)
Public Information Presentation

When: July 8, 2025 at 5:30 pm

Where: Cleveland Chinese Christian Church, 3224 Payne Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio

What: To provide information regarding the Construction of the Payne Avenue Rehabilitation Phase 2 project. **Work is scheduled to begin in July 2025 with completion in November 2026.**

The proposed improvements include:

- Full and partial depth pavement repairs as needed, and complete asphalt resurfacing
- New sidewalk, ADA-compliant curb ramps and drive aprons as necessary
- Replacement of an existing 8" water main with new connections and appurtenances
- Replacement of existing catch basins as needed
- Revise the travel lanes from 2 lanes in each direction to 1 lane in each direction with turn lanes at signalized intersections
- New bike lanes and/or sharrows will extend the length of the project and are currently being developed.
- Parking will be maintained on both sides of the street where it is feasible
- Decorative crosswalks will be replicated along the corridor
- Pedestrian signal heads will be modernized
- Low Mow Tree lawns will be added in many locations
- Trees will be planted at various locations in coordination with Urban Forestry.

Construction Cost: \$7.9 million

Funding Sources: Ohio Public Works Commission-Issue 1, City Road & Bridge Bonds and Public Utility Funds
