## Carnegie Avenue Rehabilitation Project – Phase 2 (East 79<sup>th</sup> Street to Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive) Public Information Presentation

*Where:* Cleveland Public Library, MLK Branch, 10601 Euclid Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio

## *What:* To provide information regarding the Construction of the Carnegie Avenue Rehabilitation Phase 2 project. **Construction to begin July 2025. With completion scheduled in November 2026.**

The proposed improvements include:

- Full and partial depth pavement repairs as needed, and complete asphalt resurfacing
- New sidewalk, ADA-compliant curb ramps and drive aprons as necessary
- Replacement of an existing 8" water main with a 12" water main from East 79<sup>th</sup> Street to Stearns Road
- Replacement of existing catch basins as needed
- Signal upgrades at East 83<sup>rd</sup> Street, East 90<sup>th</sup> Street, East 96<sup>th</sup> Street, East 100<sup>th</sup> Street, Stokes Boulevard, Stearns Road, MLK Jr. Drive and MLK Jr Drive/Cedar Avenue
- Existing signals at East 79<sup>th</sup> Street, East 86<sup>th</sup> Street, East 102<sup>nd</sup> Street & East 105<sup>th</sup> Street will not need upgrades.
- Providing Thermoplastic Pavement Striping for durability and upgrading road signs as necessary
- Decorative crosswalks will be replicated along the corridor
- Low Mow Tree lawns will be added in many locations

## Construction Cost: \$9.9 million

*Funding Sources:* Ohio Public Works Commission-Issue 1, City Road & Bridge Bonds and Public Utility Funds
