## City Announces Neighborhood Street Improvements

## East 64<sup>th</sup> Street, East 75<sup>th</sup> Street, Kenyon Avenue, Skylane Drive, Dornur Drive (Ward 12)

**CLEVELAND** – Beginning August 5, 2025, weather permitting, the City of Cleveland's Residential Resurfacing Program will continue in Ward 12. Advance notice signs will be posted to advise the public of road improvements. The following streets will be complete by the end of September 2025:

- East 64th Street (Harvard Avenue to Park Avenue)
- East 75th Street (Worley Avenue to Ottawa Avenue)
- Kenyon Avenue (East 59th Street to East 65th Street)
- Skylane Drive (Spring Road to North End)
- Dornur Drive (West Schaaf Road to Hilland Road)
- Dornur Drive (Hilland Road to South Hills Road)

One lane of traffic will be maintained for local traffic for the duration of each project. No detours are expected. Access to all businesses, residences and side streets will be maintained during construction. On-street parking will not be allowed during construction. The work will take place during the hours of 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
