City Announces Neighborhood Street Improvements East 24th Street, East 59th, East 64th Street, Varian Avenue, Carl Avenue, East 89th Street, Morris Court, Crawford Court, East 73rd Street (Ward 7)

CLEVELAND – During the week of August 18, 2025, weather permitting, the City of Cleveland's Residential Resurfacing Program will continue in Ward 1. Advance notice signs will be posted to advise the public of road improvements. The following streets will be completed by the end of September 2025:

- East 24th Street (Superior Avenue to St Clair Avenue)
- East 59th Street (Superior Avenue to Prosser Avenue)
- East 64th Street (St Clair Avenue to Varian Avenue)
- Varian Avenue (East 64th Street to Addison Road)
- Carl Avenue (Addison Road to Norwood Road)
- East 89th Street (Superior to Morris Court)
- Morris Court (East 89th Street to East 90th Street)
- Crawford Court (East 89th Street to East End)
- East 73rd Street (Chester Avenue to Hough Avenue)

One lane of traffic will be maintained for local traffic for the duration of each project. No detours are expected. Access to all businesses, residences and side streets will be maintained during construction. On-street parking will not be allowed during construction. The work will take place Monday through Friday during the hours of 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
