City Announces Neighborhood Street Improvements

West 54th Street, West 57th Street, West 30th Street, Woburn Avenue, Russell Lane (Ward 13)

CLEVELAND – Beginning September 8, 2025, weather permitting, the City of Cleveland's Residential Resurfacing Program will continue in Ward 13. Advance notice signs will be posted to advise the public of road improvements. The following streets will be complete by the end of October 2025:

- West 54th Street (Behrwald Avenue to Biddulph Avenue)
- West 57th Street (Bangor Avenue to Biddulph Avenue)
- West 30th Street (Broadview Road to Devonshire Road)
- Woburn Avenue (West 42nd Street to West 48th Street)
- Russell Lane (Ridge Road to Mobile Home Park Entrance)

One lane of traffic will be maintained for local traffic for the duration of each project. No detours are expected. Access to all businesses, residences and side streets will be maintained during construction. On-street parking will not be allowed during construction. The work will take place during the hours of 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
