City Announces Neighborhood Street Improvements

**Swingos Court, East 70th Street, East 56th Place, East 65th Street,
East 49th Street, Madison Court, Case Court
(Ward 5)**

CLEVELAND – Beginning September 8, 2025, weather permitting, the City of Cleveland's Residential Resurfacing Program will continue in Ward 5. Advance notice signs will be posted to advise the public of road improvements. The following streets will be complete by the end of October 2025:

- Swingos Court (East 18th Street to East 21st Street)
- East 70th Street (Cedar Avenue to Central Avenue)
- East 56th Place (Drake Avenue to Lufkin Avenue)
- East 65th Street (Woodland Avenue to Beaver Avenue)
- East 49th Street (Case Court to Outhwaite Avenue)
- Madison Court (East 78th Street to East 79th Street)
- Case Court (East 40th Street to East 49th Street)

One lane of traffic will be maintained for local traffic for the duration of each project. No detours are expected. Access to all businesses, residences and side streets will be maintained during construction. On-street parking will not be allowed during construction. The work will take place during the hours of 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
