City Announces Neighborhood Street Improvements

Weston Road, Rookwood Road, Ridgehill Road, Groton Road, Greenvale Road, Colonnade Road, and East 174th Street (Ward 10)

CLEVELAND – Beginning September 15, 2025, weather permitting, the City of Cleveland's Residential Resurfacing Program will continue in Ward 10. Advance notice signs will be posted to advise the public of road improvements. The following streets will be complete by mid-November 2025:

- Weston Road (Cliffview Road to Ridgehill Road)
- Rookwood Road (Torbenson Drive to East End)
- Ridgehill Road (Nancy Drive to Weston Road)
- Groton Road (Green Road to Greenvale Road)
- Greenvale Road (Malden Road to Groton Road)
- Colonnade Road (Euclid Avenue to Endora Road)
- East 174th Street (Pinta Street to St. Clair Avenue)

One lane of traffic will be maintained for local traffic for the duration of each project. No detours are expected. Access to all businesses, residences and side streets will be maintained during construction. On-street parking will not be allowed during construction. The work will take place during the hours of 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
