This addendum is being issued to provide the answers to the questions received by the May 29, 2025, deadline.

Questions & Responses

- 1. I have found 2 different specifications for both Pixel Pitch (PP) and Pixel Matrix (PM) and would like to have that clarified.
 - a) Part D.1, states 16mm PP and 100x400 PM
 - b) Part D1.1 Cabinet Dimensions match this PP &PM (5'6.5" x 21'3.5")
 - c) Part D1.1.1, #10 states 80x320 PM, which does not match the cabinet dimensions for the 16mm PP
 - d) Part D.1.2, A., # 12 states 20mm PP
 - e) Part D.1.3, A., 1. states 80x320 PM
 - f) Part D.1.3, A., 5. states 20mm PP

Please Specify the desired Pixel Pitch and Pixel Matrix for this bid?

- The correct Pixel Pitch (PP) shall be 16mm.
- The correct Pixel Matrix (PM) shall be 106 X 406.
- 2. Part D.1.3, Cl, 3. States the vendor supplies fiber to the owner CPP who will pull the fiber between the CPP network and sign.

Can you provide an approximate minimum run length for the fiber required?

3. Part D.6 states: Owner (CPP) will provide the required communication cable that will run underground to the base of the pylon structure.

Which one is it?

• For bidding purposes, Bidder will provide 1000 linear feet of pre-terminated cable equal to the specification description shown below. The multimode fiber optic cable will be install by CPP. Bidder will provide (1) one digital to fiber converter for CPP's use to install at the computer station with the bidder-provided control software package. One (1) fiber to digital converter will be incorporated with the LED controller as per D.1.13. The bidder will be responsible for connecting fiber optic cable to each converter after CPP installs the fiber optic cable to test the system's functionality.

4. Part D.6 last paragraph states "power provided by others to the base of the pylon structure", so I would think whoever is providing the power to the base of the sign structure would be the ones getting the Electrical Permit.

Please also confirm who is responsible for the Electrical Permit?

- CPP will be responsible for any City of Cleveland Permits.
- 5. Part D.6 last paragraph also states "Sign and electrical permits will be the responsibility of the successful bidder. (No additional monies will be allocated for permits for engineering fees).
 - CPP will be responsible for any City of Cleveland Permits.
- 6. Please confirm whether a single aluminum skirting is required across both poles, or if each pole should have its own separate skirting?
 - Since the sign spans both poles and has a shared base, a single continuous skirting is required.
- 7. Will this be a complete replacement, or will we be reusing the existing "Cleveland Public Power" sign?
 - The Cleveland Public Power billboard sign on both sides will remain and be reused without illumination.
- 8. Are we required to replace the existing structure, or can we reuse what is currently in place? I assume this is why we are discussing weights.
 - The existing structure will be reused to mount both LED screens.
- 9. Is the "Cleveland Public Power" sign illuminated? We would recommend an upgraded lighting option. It may be helpful to capture some night shots of the existing signage. If you have any if you could send our way.
 - The existing CPP signs on either side of the structure are currently not illuminated and there are no plans to illuminate in the future as part of this project. Please exclude this item from your bids.
