The purpose of this addendum is to advise all vendors of the following information:

Sections A "Instructions to Bidders" and B "General Conditions" are standard City of Cleveland documents. Any bid specific conditions, and requirements, are found in Section C and D of the bid documents.

Answer to additional questions submitted

Question:

Good Afternoon,

Thank you for directing me to this information. We have received Addendum 2 and we find that the only the yellow highlighted part of the question below was answered. However, the portion highlighted in green has not been answered.

"Thank you for your response to our question, however, we need more clarification regarding our question to be able to proceed with a bid submission for this 1TB. Currently, we will still have to take an exception to the warranty language in Section B-29 of the General Conditions as the response to our question did not confirm or deny that the terms "merchantable product" and "fit and suitable for their intended purposes" are specifically limited to the explicit specifications and requirements stated in the 1TB. As such, our legal department continues to be concerned with the vagueness of those two terms. If we can get confirmation that the above is true and our standard warranties would apply otherwise, we would have no other concerns. If we are unable to get further clarification, we might be forced to submit a No-Bid for this 1TB, regrettably, so as not to waste the City's time reviewing a response that will be disqualified for including exception language which deviates from the bid document."

We need to know if our standard manufacturer warranties will apply beyond the clarification regarding merchantability and intended use.

Answer:

C-13 ACCURACY AND FLOW RATE GUARANTEE

See revised C-13 B. below for clarity

The register shall be warranted against defects in materials and workmanship for a period of at least 20 years and 6 months from the date of shipment, as evidenced by a copy of **the manufacturer's published warranty**. A pro-rated warranty is acceptable for this period

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Manufacturer's warranties will apply provided the product meets the minimum requirements of section C-13.
