



The Respiratory Report summarizes influenza, COVID-19, and Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) activity in the City of Cleveland during each week of respiratory illness season. Respiratory illness season starts at the beginning of October (MMWR week 40\*) and lasts until mid-May the following year (MMWR week 20).

## Week 40 Summary

- 1.2% of emergency department (ED) visits were for influenza-like illness (ILI) plus fever.
- Zero (0) hospitalizations and deaths were reported for influenza, COVID, or RSV this week. Hospitalization and death data often experience a delay in reporting, so more data for this week may appear on future reports.

\*An MMWR week is the CDC’s standard weekly calendar for tracking health data. Each week runs Sunday to Saturday. Each year, Week 1 is the first week of the year that has at least four days in the calendar year. 2025 contains 53 MMWR weeks. Data extracted on 10/9/2025. Data are preliminary and subject to change.
