



The Respiratory Report summarizes influenza, COVID-19, and Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) activity in the City of Cleveland during each week of respiratory illness season. Respiratory illness season starts at the beginning of October (MMWR week 40*) and lasts until mid-May the following year (MMWR week 20).

Week 42 Summary

- 1% of emergency department (ED) visits were for influenza-like illness (ILI) plus fever.
- There was 1 hospitalization for COVID reported this week. Hospitalization and death data often experience a delay in reporting, so more data for this week may appear on future reports.
- CDPH is investigating 1 COVID-19 outbreak in a congregate care setting.

*An MMWR week is the CDC's standard weekly calendar for tracking health data. Each week runs Sunday to Saturday.
