- **PURPOSE:** To ensure all members of the Cleveland Division of Police maintain a current photo identification card.
- **POLICY:** *It is the policy of the Cleveland Division of Police* to issue each member a photo identification card as standard equipment and provide a schedule for replacement.

PROCEDURES:

- I. Issuing and Replacing Identification Cards
 - A. All newly hired or promoted members shall have their photo taken at the Photography Unit and receive an identification card immediately upon hire or promotion.
 - B. Supervisors shall inspect the identification cards of members in their unit twice a year.
 - 1. Identification cards are valid for five years.
 - 2. Members with expired cards shall report to the Photography Unit for a replacement.
 - C. No overtime shall accrue as a result of receiving a new or replacement identification card.
- II. Wearing Identification Cards
 - A. Officers shall display their identification card on the outermost garment when not in uniform in a Division building or the Justice Center.
 - B. Civilian members shall display their identification card on the outermost garment when in a Division building.
- III. Lost, Damaged, or Stolen Identification Cards
 - A. Identification cards are City Property, and members shall follow the procedures in General Police Order 6.04.03, City Property Lost, Stolen, or Damaged as appropriate.

THIS ORDER SUPERSEDES ANY PREVIOUSLY ISSUED DIRECTIVE OR POLICY FOR THIS SUBJECT AND WILL REMAIN EFFECTIVE UNTIL RESCINDED OR SUPERSEDED.
