Pipeline Infrastructure Improvements Update

Thursday, April 14, 2025

Enbridge Gas Ohio - Pipeline Infrastructure Replacement Project

PIR 3809 – Wyatt Road and Palda Drive

(Ward 1)

CLEVELAND – On Thursday April 14, 2025, an Enbridge Gas Ohio pipeline infrastructure replacement project will begin on the following streets:

- Wyatt Road – From Miles Avenue to Palda Drive
- East 167 Street – East side from Miles Avenue to Palda Drive
- East 173 Street – West side from Palda Drive to Dynes Avenue
- East 175 Street – From Miles Avenue to Garden Boulevard
- Palda Drive – From 17001 Palda Drive to East 175 Street
- Ridgeton Drive – From East 167 Street to Wyatt Road
- Ridgeton Drive – South Side from Wyatt Road to East 175 Street
- Wayne Drive – From Ridgeton Drive to Wyatt Road
- Wayne Drive – North Side from Wyatt Road to East 175 Street
- Miles Avenue – From East 167 Street to Cleveland City Line

The improvements include replacing the old steel mainline with a new plastic mainline in the roadway and sidewalk area. A work zone will be established which will allow two-way traffic with traffic control personnel present to help direct traffic flow. Access to adjacent driveways and businesses will be maintained throughout construction. The work on the project will take place Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

This project is scheduled for completion in July 2025. Permanent restorations will be completed by late September 2025.
