Pipeline Infrastructure Improvements Update

Dominion Energy Ohio Gas Pipeline Infrastructure Replacement Project – P 401658909 – Harvard Avenue and East 64th Street (City of Cleveland - Ward 12)

CLEVELAND – On Tuesday, October 18, 2022, Dominion Energy Ohio’s gas pipeline infrastructure replacement project will begin on the following streets:

- Harvard Avenue – South side from East 64th Street to East 59th Street
- East 64th Street – West side from 4096 East 64th Street to Harvard Avenue

The improvements include installing new plastic gas main line extensions within the roadway and sidewalk area. A work zone will be established which will allow two-way traffic with traffic control personnel present to help direct traffic flow. Access to adjacent sidewalks, driveways and businesses will be maintained throughout construction. The work on the project will take place Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

This project is scheduled for completion in mid- November 2022. Should the weather not allow for permanent restoration to the sidewalk and roadway after construction, a temporary 2” thick concrete sidewalk will be installed for pedestrian traffic, and concrete road caps will be placed on all road crossings until permanent restorations can be completed in the Spring 2023.
