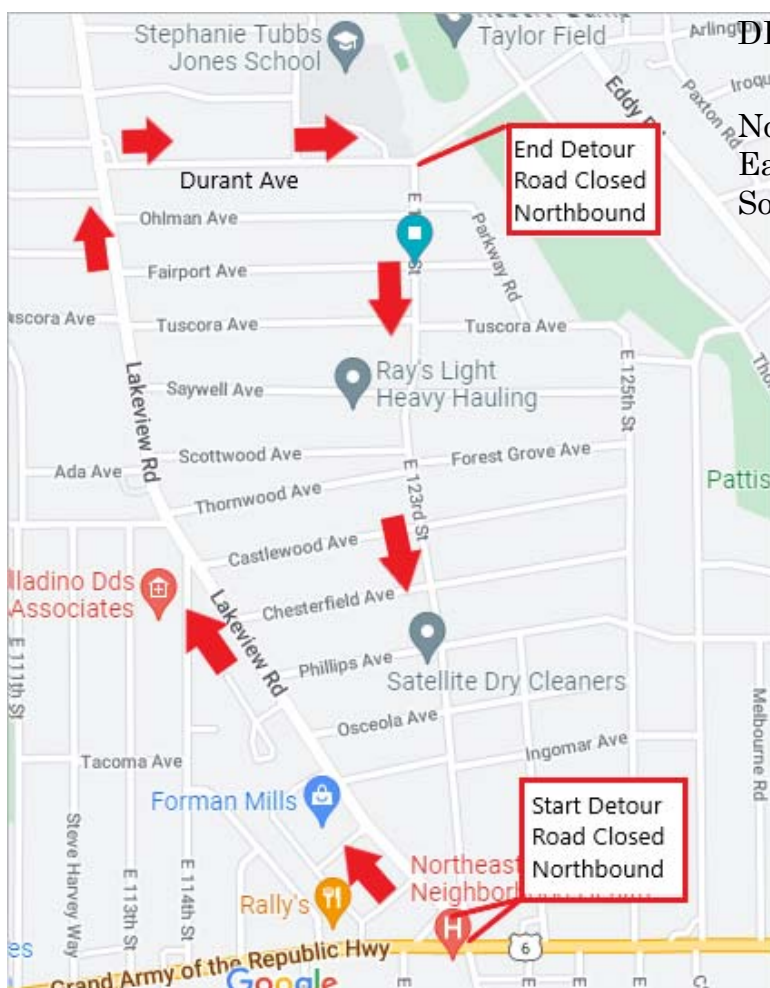

East 123rd Street Concrete Slab Repair Project Superior Avenue to Durant Avenue (Ward 9)

CLEVELAND – Beginning the week of November 7, 2022, weather permitting, the City will begin concrete slab repair and replacement on East 123rd Street between Superior Avenue and Durant Avenue (0.7 miles). A portion of the street will be closed and one lane will be maintained southbound. A detour will be in place for the duration of the project and no on-street parking will be permitted for the duration of the project.



DETOUR ROUTE:

North on Lakeview Road
East on Durant Avenue
South on East 123rd Street

The project includes removing and replacing concrete slabs within the project limits as well as adjusting castings. This project is the first phase of a two phase project. This

work, Phase 1, is expected to be completed by the end of December 2022. The work will take place during the hours of 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
