Payne Avenue Rehabilitation Project – Phase 1

(East 13th Street to East 30th Street)

Public Information Presentation

When: June 14, 2023 at 6:00 pm

Where: Cleveland Chinese Christian Church, 3224 Payne Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio

What: To provide information regarding the Design of the Payne Avenue Rehabilitation project. **Final Design is scheduled to be completed in September 2023. Construction is scheduled to begin April 2024.**

The proposed improvements include:

- Full and partial depth pavement repairs as needed, and complete asphalt resurfacing
- New sidewalk, ADA-compliant curb ramps and drive aprons as necessary
- Replacement of an existing 8" water main with a 12" water main from East 13th Street to East 30th Street
- Replacement of existing catch basins as needed
- Revise the travel lanes from 2 lanes in each direction to 1 lane in each direction with turn lanes at signalized intersections
- New bike lanes and/or sharrows will extend the length of the project
- Parking will be maintained on both sides of the street where it is feasible
- Decorative crosswalks will be replicated along the corridor
- Pedestrian signal heads will be modernized
- Remove concrete tree lawns and replace with grass tree lawn in certain areas and coordinate with Urban Forestry to add trees where feasible
- Trees will be planted at various locations in coordination with Urban Forestry.

Construction Cost: \$7.2 million

Funding Sources: Ohio Public Works Commission-Issue 1, City Road & Bridge Bonds and Public Utility Funds
