Euclid Avenue Stormwater/Slope Stabilization Project
Traffic Advisory
Near 17914 Euclid Avenue
(Ward 10)

CLEVELAND – Beginning the week of January 9, 2023, weather permitting, the City of Cleveland will begin a stormwater control/slope stabilization project on Euclid Avenue near 17914 Euclid Avenue. A portion of the roadway will be closed and one lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction. A complete closure is not expected to occur.

The project includes excavation, placement of low strength mortar and rock channel protection. The majority of the work will take place from the back of the sidewalk to the curb. On-street parking, in the area adjacent to the work, will not be permitted. The work will take place during the hours of 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. and is expected to complete by the end of February 2023.
