**East 185th Street Rehabilitation &
Streetscape Project
Traffic Advisory
Nottingham Road to Lake Erie
(Ward 8)**

Expect additional traffic notices as improvements continue

CLEVELAND – Beginning Monday May 16, 2022, weather permitting, the City will begin construction of Phase 1 of the East 185th Street Rehabilitation & Streetscape Project in the Cities of Cleveland and Euclid.

Overall Project Description:

Work includes the rehabilitation of approximately 1.63 miles of East 185th Street, from Nottingham Road to Lake Erie. Work will include sidewalk, new curb, drive aprons, new watermain, drainage structures, new traffic signals, traffic control, signage, streetscape and pavement markings. Work also includes milling of existing asphalt and replacement, along with full depth repairs, utility castings adjustments, public art, site amenities and new landscaping.

Construction Phasing:

The project will be constructed in 2 phases in 2022 and 2023. Phase 1 will construct East 185th Street from Pawnee Avenue to Lake Erie and the southernmost section between Nottingham Road and Villaview Road. Phase 1 will be completed in 2022. Phase 2 will construct Villaview Road to Pawnee Avenue in 2023.

Part-width construction will be used for each phase. One northbound traffic lane will be during construction the Pawnee to Lake Erie and Villaview to Pawnee sections of work. Two-way traffic will be maintained in the Nottingham Road to Villaview Road section.

Maintenance of Traffic:

Phase 1 work is scheduled to begin starting May 16, 2022, weather permitting. One-way traffic will be maintained during construction in the northbound direction between Pawnee Avenue and Lake Erie. On street parking will be permitted on the side of the

roadway being maintained during construction. Southbound traffic will be detoured from E. 185th Street to eastbound Lakeshore Boulevard to southbound E. 200th Street to westbound St. Clair Avenue. Two-way traffic will be maintained between Nottingham Road and Pawnee Avenue.

Construction zones and detours will be installed independently for each phase. Additional side street closures may be necessary at times during construction. Detour signs will be posted as these occur. Advanced warning signs will be placed outside of the work area informing the public of the construction work and any changes in the traffic patterns.

The work will generally take place during the hours of 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Note about Concurrent Work:

Dominion Energy Ohio (DEO) will be relocating pipe at the E. 185th Street/Lakeshore intersection beginning in May 2022. This work will be done in advance of and concurrently with the E. 185th Street improvements.
