**West 116th Street Brick Restoration Project Traffic
Advisory
Lorain Avenue to Triskett Road
(Ward 11)**

CLEVELAND – During the week of August 15, 2022, weather permitting, the City will begin brick restoration of West 116th Street from Lorain Avenue to Triskett Road. A complete closure is not expected to occur. No on-street parking will be permitted for the duration of the project.

The project will remove the various concrete caps in the street and replace it with brick. The work will take place during the hours of 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. The brick restoration project is expected to complete by the end of September 2022.
