West 117th Street Concrete Slab Repair Project **Worthington Avenue to Geraldine Avenue** **(Ward 11)**

CLEVELAND – Beginning the week of December 5, 2022, weather permitting, the City will begin concrete slab repair and replacement on West 117th Street between Worthington Avenue and Geraldine Avenue (1.0 mile). A portion of the street will be closed and one lane will be maintained in each direction. There is no detour expected at this time and no on-street parking will be permitted for the duration of the project.

The project includes removing and replacing concrete slabs within the project limits as well as adjusting castings. This work is expected to be completed by the end of December 2022. The work will take place during the hours of 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
