Frank Avenue Extension Project

Traffic Advisory

**East 105th Street to East 101st Street
(City of Cleveland - Ward 6)**

Expect additional traffic notices as improvements continue

CLEVELAND – Beginning Monday, March 6, 2023, weather permitting, the City of Cleveland will begin the Frank Avenue Extension Project from East 105th Street to East 101st Street.

Overall Project Description:

The project includes construction of new roadway to provide access through the New Innovation Square Development. Work includes installing new pavement, curbs, ADA compliant curb ramps, walks, sewers, waterworks, street lighting and street landscaping.

The work on this project will take place Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. The entire project is scheduled for completion in July 2023.

Maintenance of Traffic:

East 103rd Street will be closed to through traffic between Quebec Avenue and Cedar Avenue. Northbound traffic will be detoured to the west on Quebec Avenue; then north on East 100th Street to Cedar Avenue. Southbound traffic will be detoured to the east on Cedar Avenue; then south on East 105th Street to Quebec Avenue.

East 101st Street: Southbound traffic will be maintained all the time. Northbound traffic will be detoured to the west on Quebec Avenue; then north on East 100th Street to Cedar Avenue.

Access to residences and businesses will be maintained throughout construction. Detour signs will be placed outside of the work area informing the public of the construction work and any changes in the traffic patterns.
