1	15-180	Brown	HH	<p>The CPRB recommended a <b>Group III</b> discipline level for Sgt. Ivey #9212's allegation of Excessive Force when he utilized more force than necessary to bring the Complainant's son back into the store.</p> <p>The CPRB also recommended a <b>Group I</b> discipline level for Sgt. Ivey's failure to generate a use of less lethal force report.</p> <p>Chief Williams <b>dismissed</b> both allegations, citing that there were no videos or independent witnesses not associated with the Complainant that witnessed the actions.</p> <p>The CPRB voted to appeal this decision to the Safety Director.</p>	<p>Director Howard, after reviewing all evidence, <b>upheld the Chief's dismissal</b>, citing that there were several inconsistencies by the witnesses regarding the amount of force used, and those inconsistencies do not confidently allow for a finding of guilt of excessive force by a preponderance of the evidence.</p> <p>Director Howard further stated that Sgt. Ivey was not reasonably required to generate a report for conduct that did not arise to force.</p>
