IX (A). REVIEW OF CHIEF DISCIPLINARY DECISIONS

1	19-184	Niedes-Santiago	Delaney	<p>WCS Violation – the CPRB recommended a Group I category for P.O. Madej’s #2078 failure to activate his WCS at the onset of his encounter with the Complainant.</p> <p>Improper Stop/Detainment – the CPRB recommended a Group II category for P.O. Wagner’s #1802 when he stopped the Complainant’s passenger without reasonable suspicion that he had committed a crime.</p> <p>Improper Frisk, Unprofessional Conduct and WCS Violation – the CPRB recommended a Group I category for P.O. Wagner when he frisked and detained the Complainant’s passenger without reasonable suspicion and/or a legitimate reason to do so under the procedures for officer safety; when he asked the Complainant if his apartment complex was connected to HIV patients during the traffic stop; and when he failed to activate his WCS at the onset of his encounter with the Complainant.</p>	<p>Chief Williams concurred with the CPRB recommendation and issued P.O. Madej a letter of reinstruction.</p> <p>Chief Williams departed from the CPRB recommendation and dismissed the allegations of Improper Stop/Detainment, Improper Frisk and Unprofessional Conduct, citing that P.O. Wagner determined that the Complainant’s passenger violated the seatbelt law, and that his placement of the passenger in the zone car in connection with the seatbelt violation and not having identification was proper and not for “officer convenience only.” Further, Chief Williams stated that P.O. Wagner was merely having a conversation with the Complainant when the Complainant mentioned the illness of his wife, and that P.O. Wagner was cordial and professional throughout the encounter.</p> <p>Chief Williams concurred with the CPRB recommendation for the WCS Violation and issued P.O. Wagner a three-day suspension.</p>

Weaver’s #9172 filling out a citizen complaint form on behalf of the Complainant, with full knowledge that he was the subject of the complaint.	Chief Williams concurred with the CRPB recommendation and issued Sgt. Weaver a letter of reinstruction .
