1	18-102	Williams	Bowker	Lack of Service	Chief Williams dismissed the allegation of Lack of Service, citing that the allegation was proven false for several reasons: State law mandates that all school districts report all allegations of sexual assault and Det. Kellums was unable to locate any police report; Det. Kellums was unable to identify or locate the suspect based on the first name and description provided by the Complainant; Det. Kellums was unable to definitively determine that the Complainant attended the school where the assault took place, and; the CRCC advocate recommended that the Det. Kellums close the case.
2	18-150	Williams	Wynne	Lack of Service WCS Violation	Chief Williams sustained both allegations against Det. Bellanca, but departed from the recommended group discipline level, citing that the Lack of Service does not rise to the level of a Group II offense. Chief Williams issued Det. Bellanca a three-day suspension.



3	18-166	Radwan	Oliver	Unprofessional Conduct	<p>Chief Williams dismissed the allegation of Unprofessional Conduct against Sgt. Jackson, stating that the initial interaction between Sgt. Jackson and the Complainant was one of chaos, misinformation, and misunderstanding, but at the completion of the incident Sgt. Jackson was able to correct the multiple misunderstandings.</p> <p>There has been no discipline determination as of yet for P.O. Marzan or P.O. Haggerty.</p>

Tusing, citing that there is no reference in the manual as to when or at what point the interview with the suspect should be conducted. Director McGrath determined that Det. Tusing interviewed the suspect and conducted a thorough investigation.</p>
