Pipeline Infrastructure Improvements Update

**Monday, August 28, 2017, Dominion East Ohio Gas Pipeline Infrastructure Replacement
Project – PIR 2917
Stearns Road & Carnegie Avenue.
(City of Cleveland Ward 6)**

Expect additional traffic notices as work progresses

CLEVELAND – Pipeline infrastructure improvements begin on Monday, August 28, 2017 and include work on the following street:

- Stearns Road at Carnegie Avenue – From the south side of the Carnegie Avenue and Stearns Road intersection and then north 250' along the east side of Stearns Road.

The project scope is to replace the old 20" steel intermediate pressure mainline and valves with new 20" coated steel mainline and valves. At least one lane of traffic will be maintained at all times in each direction on Carnegie Avenue with traffic control personnel in the work zone(s) directing traffic.

A Law Enforcement Officer (L.E.O.) will be present at all signalized intersections. Rush hour restrictions apply to traffic flow on Carnegie Avenue (No work will be performed on the west bound traffic lanes until after 9:00 A. M. and work must be completed prior to 3:00 P.M. on all east bound traffic lanes). Access to adjacent driveways will be maintained throughout construction and the work will take place Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
